The Wayne Densch Performing Arts Center (formerly the Helen Stairs Theatre, and the Ritz Theatre in the early 1920s through the 1990s), has been renovated in the heart of historic downtown Sanford. The theatre features productions by several groups, including the Wekiva River Players, The Orlando City Ballet, Seminole Community College and many more.

Both Longwood and Sanford respectively have enjoyed renovations of their historic downtown areas, each city boasting numerous building listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
